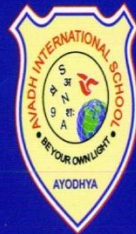

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INTRODUCTION:-

Avadh International School is a part of Shambhu Narain Hari Narain Foundation which was established with a purpose for providing education to this semi-rural area. The school has a vast-pastoral six acre expanse and located in serene and pollution free environment. The **Avadh International School** is a brain child of Mr. Atul Kumar Singh who felt the need of good institution for rural & semi rural region of Ayodhya. The idea of institution inculcating the needs of first generation learners of this region was finalized on 8th April 2003. The school was affiliated to CBSE Delhi on 1st April 2006, upgraded to class XII in 2007 for Science and Commerce streams. In the year 2019 the Humanities stream too was introduced. The school is equipped with Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Computer and Math Labs. The school has well Stocked library as well as indoor and outdoor games facilities. Subjects offered for classes XI-XII are English, Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Informatics Practices, Physical And Health Education, Biology, Accounts, Economics, Business Studies, History, Political Science, Geography, Legal Studies, Sociology, Painting, Vocal Music And Hindi Elective for the session 2020-21 onwards.

ACCESSIBILITY TO THE PRINCIPAL

In order to discuss individual problem or any other problem of child or any suggestion for betterment of school the parents can have a meeting with the Principal with prior appointment after school hours on any working day.

REGISTRATION AND ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Admission will be made on the basis of age, physical and mental development. Admission to a suitable group will be provided after pre admission interview and test in main subject

- Prospectus and registration forms for admission to the school may be obtained from the school office on all working days, provided vacancy exists in the respective class.
- The admission form should be duly filled and submitted with the required documents/enclosures and certificates as mentioned in the form latest by 7 days from the admission.
- There is no test for admission in class Nursery.
- Registered applicants will be called for an entrance test/interview for various classes.
- Admission is granted strictly on the basis of written test and the interview for classes LKG and above.
- Fee has to be deposited within three days of selection, failing which the seat will be allotted to the next candidate in the waiting list.
- The decision of the Principal in matters of admission and placement shall be final.

Note: Children seeking admission in Nursery and LKG should have attained the age of 3 and 4 years respectively as on first April of the year.



RULES REGARDING FEES REMITTANCE

- Fee will be remitted on quarterly basis i.e. three months.
 - (a) First quarter April to June (in April).
 - (b) Second quarter July to September (in July).
 - (c) Third quarter October to December (in October).
 - (d) Fourth quarter January to March (in January).
- Fees should be deposited in cash/cheque between 1st to 15th April, July, October and January falling which the fees (with fine) can be deposited on 25th and 30th of (April, July, October and January) from 9.00 a.m. to 2.00 p.m. Fees of last quarter will be taken in cash only.
- The newly admitted children would have to pay the first quarter fees in cash.
- The late fee is Rs. 100/- if fee deposited on 30th and Rs. 200/- will be charged in case fee is paid after one month.
- If fee of the quarter is not deposited in the months of April, July, October and January, the name of the child will be struck off the roll.
- If child has attended school even for a day in any month, fee will be charged appropriately.
- Fee card should be presented at the time of fee deposit for entries in the card.
- Cheques should be in favour of " AVADH INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL" payable at Ayodhya.
- Cheques from out station and non clearing house member banks will not be acceptable.
- Each cheque should have name, class and section of the child written on the back side of the cheque.
- If the cheque is dishonored a fine of Rs. 300/- will be charged.
- Parent(s) desirous to pay the fees of the session at a time can do it by cash, cheque or demand draft.
- Re-admission is on the discretion of the Principal after the name has been struck off due to non-payment of the fee.
- Re-admission fee is Rs. 2500/-
- All dues of the session must be cleared in the month of January.

EXAMINATION AND PROMOTION RULES

The school strictly adheres to examination bye-laws of CBSE.

LEAVE, MEDICAL, WITHDRAWAL AND DISMISSAL

The school is affiliated to CBSE therefore leave, medical and withdrawal procedure will be as per CBSE rules viz.

- A. Leave will be granted if the student gets prior approval from the Principal.
- B. Medical leave should be duly supported by medical certificate provided by the M.B.B.S. Doctor only.
- C. For appearing in any examination minimum attendance must be 75% of working days.



- D. If a parent is desirous to remove his/her ward from the school then –
- (a) A proper application is to be submitted to the Principal of the school.
 - (b) A clearance certificate is to be produced.
 - (c) T.C. will be issued only if above conditions are fulfilled.
- E. The school authorities have discretion for dismissal on following grounds-
- (a) The student is undisciplined, using abusive language and has unruly behavior both inside school campus and outside also.
 - (b) The student is in possession of malicious material.
 - (c) Advocates or preaches sectarian views.

FACILITIES:-

1. LIBRARY: – The school has a well furnished library and reading room. A wide range of books for various age groups along with Encyclopedia, reference books, Journals, News Papers and Periodicals will be made available for reading and use. The library contains nearly 5000 books of various subjects which are used by both students and teachers. Apart from it, the institution gets monthly periodicals and magazines to enhance the knowledge of teachers and students.

LIBRARY RULES:-

- A. Students of the school are members of the library.
 - B. Discipline in the library must be maintained at all cost.
 - C. Only one book can be borrowed at a time.
 - D. Books can be issued and returned only in the library period of the concerned class.
 - E. Books should be properly looked after and returned on its due date.
 - F. If a book is lost or destroyed the cost of the book with fine will be recovered from the student.
 - G. Students are allowed to borrow books for a period of 10 days. No dues certificate is to be obtained from the librarian while leaving the school.
- 2. LABORATORIES:** – School has well equipped and well furnished labs of Physics, Chemistry, Biology. Here the students test the laws of natural sciences.

In order to promote scientific temper amongst juniors, the school has a composite lab where activities related to Basic sciences are performed.

- 3. COMPUTER LAB:** – The school has two computer labs one for seniors and the other for juniors. In addition to that students are encouraged to learn the machine languages.
- 4. MATHEMATICS LAB** - Mathematics is completely man made as such it is based on axiom, lemmas etc. However, the conjecture here is how mathematics can be related to other spheres of human activities be it scientific, economic or social.
- 5. GAMES AND SPORTS** – The school provides each class with a period for games and sports every day. The students are encouraged to participate in more than one game. Each sport has well qualified coach. The games Kabbadi, Kho-Kho, Basket Ball, Foot Ball, Volley ball, Table Tennis, Chess etc. to name a few.



6. **HOBBIES AND CLUB ACTIVITIES** – The school provides one period every day which encourages every student to pursue his or her hobbies. The teacher have plays the role of facilitator. This is free of charge.

7. **SECURITY AND SAFETY:-** There 24X7 surveillance of school campus and students using CCTV. The school buses are GPS enabled and fitted with latest tracking devices.

8. **TRANSPORT FACILITY**

The school has a fleet of buses available to take the children to and fro. The school buses will ply accord'ng to route chart. Parents will have to opt for the bus facility at the time of the admission/opening of the school, Transportation charges must also be paid in installments along with the school fee.

- A. It will be responsibility of the parent(s) to bring and take their ward from the nearest pick-up point.
- B. Transport fee must be deposited along with school fee.
- C. Once opted for transport, there is no option for leaving; the fees of entire session will be taken (12months).
- D. Any damage done to the transport by the student will be borne by the parents.
- E. Route, location, telephone number of parent(s) guardian should be duly filled in the application for transport.

The school provides transport facilities to all those who seek for it, subject to the rules laid by the institution. The transport facility is available for regions in and around Ayodhya region.

PARENT ADVISORY COUNCIL

The school has Parent Advisory Council (PAC) whose members are the parents from each class and locality. The PAC acts as our eyes and ears which provides necessary feedback that helps us to understand children better.

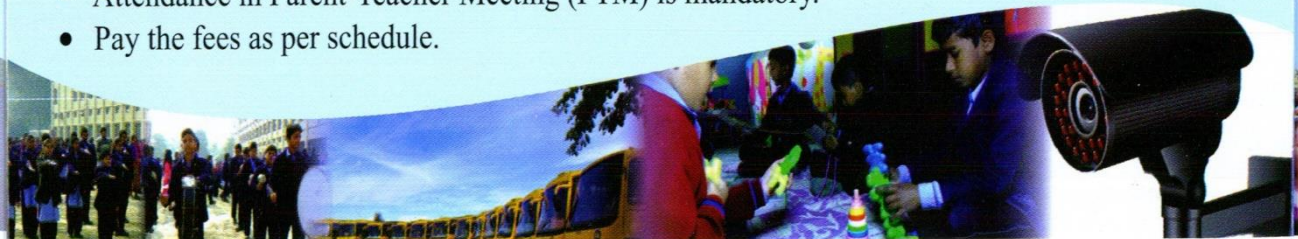
MESSAGE FOR PARENTS AND GUARDIANS:-

The Management and Teachers of **AVADH INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL** are committed for imparting quality education and development of their students. We need your active co-operation and constructive suggestions for constant improvement.

Also please pay attention to the following aspects-

DOS

- Use the school diary as a means of communication with the class teacher and check the diary for home work and the teachers remark, if any.
- Sign the copies/papers when sent home.
- Ensure that your ward comes to school in proper uniform with polished shoes, trimmed hair (except Sikh students) and clipped nails.
- Send the children regularly and punctually to school. No absence will be permitted without leave application and late comers will not be allowed to sit in the class without the permission of the Principal.
- Attendance in Parent-Teacher Meeting (PTM) is mandatory.
- Pay the fees as per schedule.



- Parents must notify to the class teacher about the mode of conveyance used by the students.
- Parent(s) must provide their mobile number which is working for sending SMS and for communication. In case of change of numbers / address, the school authorities must be informed immediately.

DON'TS –

- Send the child to school in case of infectious disease.
- Engage school teachers as private tutor. Private tuition is not encouraged in the school.
- Tip any school employee.
- Criticise the teacher or school in the presence of the student.
- Walk to the class room or meet the teacher in the class room.
- Do not allow your ward to bring valuables to the school.
- Please do not allow your ward to miss school for minor reasons.

REMEDIAL CLASSES

The school has full faith in multiple intelligence of each child. However due to linear Psychometric evaluation of our education system, we do provide remedial classes after school hours free of charge.

WORKSHOP AND TEACHER EDUCATION:-

We firmly believe in the development of teachers in terms of knowledge, teaching and learning, Academic excursions and exchange programme. We organize regular workshop in association with centre of excellence of CBSE and send the teachers for various courses conducted by educational institutes.

SOCIAL SERVICE:-

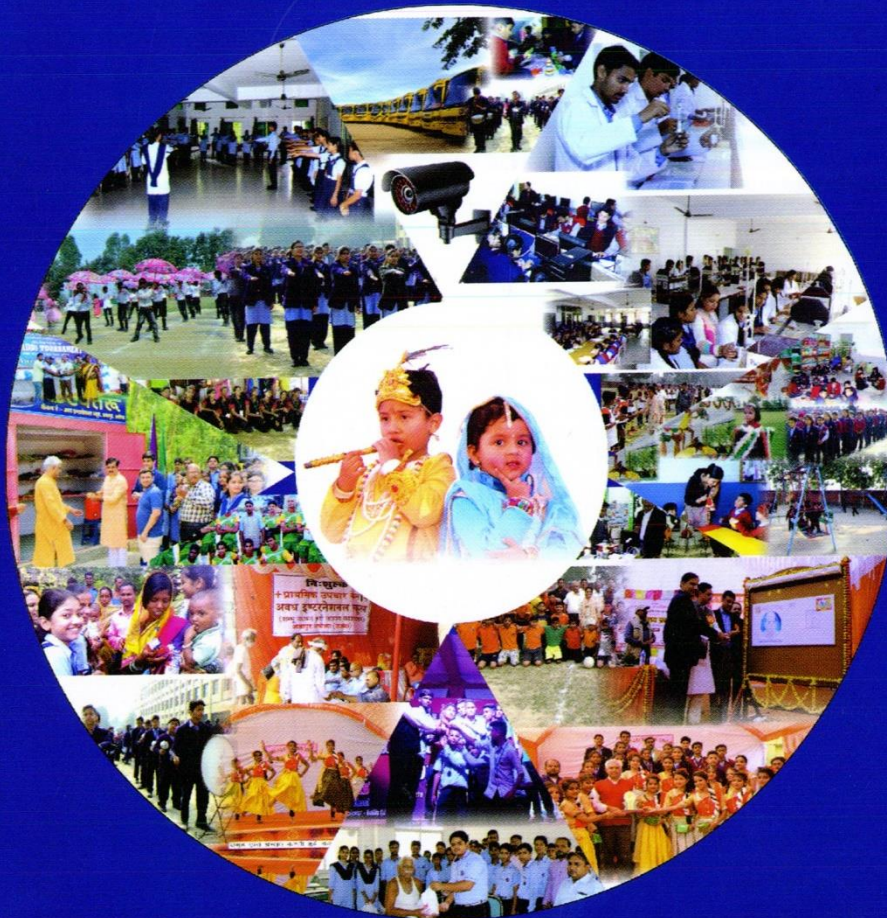
The parent body of the school i.e. **Shambhu Narain Hari Narain Foundation** and **Kalptaru** is involved in social services by our social representatives. This involves free distribution of Medicines, Clothes, Utensils and fruits to patients. The school is involved in awareness campaigns like exercise of franchise, communicable diseases etc.

STUDENTS PARLIAMENT:-

In order to inculcate the democratic values in our students we have students Parliament. This parliament consists of the two elected representatives of each section of each class. This parliament meets on every Wednesday of the week and deliberates on various issues related to the education, discipline, facilities etc. They present to the Principal the resolutions of the meeting through Prime Minister and his/her cabinet.
